## Travel Club Passport to Adventure





## Extraordinary General Meeting

What you need to know....



The EGM held on Sunday, 22nd February, saw an excellent turnout of Service, Women's Section, and Associate Members. Its main purpose was to report Tauranga RSA's decision not to merge with us, and to find a way forward to ensure the future of the Club.

Robust debate went for around two hours to arrive at a motion put forward by Allan Liddell, empowering the Committee to investigate three options for the secure future of the Club.

The options are to amalgamate with Club Mount Maunganui; to develop the land in conjunction with a developer and an already interested tenant, or to sell the land. If we merge with Club Mount Maunganui we will share in a relatively new building and, in my opinion, it is better to have one strong club than two weak ones. We are very near neighbours and many of our members also belong to Club Mount Maunganui, as do I.

Developing the land upon which the Club sits presents an amazing opportunity, with a major national tenant very interested in taking tenancy, thanks to a developer that has them on their books. A 50-50 share with the developer, feasibly for at least the next 50 years, would boost the Club's income substantially in terms of rent, and future Club executives wouldn't have to worry how to get the club through tough times, with sufficient income to support our Welfare and Club activities.

We would also own the air space above the car parking area, a sizeable space which could be further developed in later years to accommodate, for example, a high rise building, in keeping with progress and development opportunities in the area. Obviously this would be costly in the present economic climate, so one step at a time.

We have four snooker tournaments over the next few weeks as well as our ANZAC parade to prepare for, so our focus for now is financially keep this Club going, and working through the details of a way forward that suits this Club and its members.

We are now preparing for the next EGM where we, your Executive, will provide updates on all of the options on the table. It is my hope that we will reach a consensus in finding a positive way forward.
